Contest Information

There will be two categories with one overall winner.

The two categories are:

- A. Double Crust Apple Pie B. Crumb Topping Apple Pie

A total of 60 apple pies will be accepted for judging (30 from each category).

Recipes will be accepted between November 1 and December 31.

Finalists will be notified by January 8, 2010.

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

1st Place - \$500 plus trip for two to Florida

2nd Place - \$250 plus overnight package at Zehnder's Splash Village Hotel and Waterpark

3rd Place - \$100 plus dinner for 4 at Zehnder's Restaurant

A \$5.00 registration fee is required. All registration fees will be returned to entries not selected as a finalist.

Rules

1. Recipes must include Michigan Apples (please include variety - no Granny Smith Apples). Check michiganapples.com for a complete list of Michigan Apples.
2. Recipes must use Pioneer Sugar.
3. Recipes must be received between Nov. 1 and December 31, 2009.
4. Only one recipe per person can be submitted per category.
5. Winners must be present during contest & judging.
6. Recipes become property of Zehnder's of Frankenmuth, Michigan Sugar, Michigan Apple Committee & WSGW Radio.
7. Each finalist will be asked to bring his or her prepared apple pie to the contest on January 27, 2010 at Zehnder's Snowfest in Frankenmuth, Michigan.
8. Finalists' pies will be judged on appearance, taste and overall impression.
9. First Place winner automatically becomes a judge for next year's contest.
10. Contestant must be a Michigan Resident.
11. Eligibility: Amateur cooks/bakers 18 and older only. (An amateur cook/baker is any person who does not make the major portion of their income baking or cooking.)
