



RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

REQUIREMENTS

Must be female, at least 18 years old (by end of June, 2008) and not older than 23 (during her reign). You must never have been married and have no minor dependents. You must remain single for the entire reign.

Must be committed to serving as the Michigan Sugar Queen or Court attendant for a full year from crowning. This may include as many as 30 official appearances including, but not limited to parades, festivals and events. This will require the queen and court to be available on weekends.

Must be friendly, courteous, not use tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or drugs when appearing at official functions as Michigan Sugar Queen or Court attendant.

The queen and her court will host a continental breakfast Saturday morning June 21, 2008 at the Michigan Sugar Company office, ride on the Michigan Sugar float during the parade and remain in the park for a few hours Saturday afternoon.

The outgoing Michigan Sugar Queen and Court will appear on Friday evening the following year to crown the incoming Queen and Court and will ride the Sebewaing Chamber of Commerce float on Saturday of the Sugar Festival.

RULES

Applicants must be a resident of a county where sugarbeets are grown. {Arenac, Bay, Clare, Clinton, Genesee, Gladwin, Gratiot, Huron, Ionia, Iosco, Isabella, Lapeer, Macomb, Midland, Montcalm, Ogemaw, Saginaw, Sanilac, Shiawassee, St. Clair and Tuscola}.

A parent/guardian will be required to attend any overnight events as a chaperon. {All overnight arrangements and payments will be handled by the coordinator at Michigan Sugar Company}.

APPEARANCES

Must appear on stage in formal attire on Friday, June 20, 2008 the evening of the Sugar Festival. After crowning, the queen may choose to make a short speech.

The queen and court members will be required to attend the Queen Candidate Luncheon the following year and give a short speech to the candidates regarding her past year's experiences as Sugar Queen or Court representative.

Safety suggestion: Have a parent/guardian attend each parade, festival or event as a chaperon. The queen/court members can decide who this will be.
