Michigan Sugar Co., Saginaw Spirit team up on Sweet Shot of the Game

Partnership to benefit Rescue Ministries of Mid-Michigan

BAY CITY – Michigan Sugar Company is pleased to announce a new partnership with the Saginaw Spirit hockey team for the 2018-2019 season. As part of the partnership, Michigan Sugar will become the presenting sponsor of the "Sweet Shot of the Game" announced during the third period at each of the 34 Spirit home games this season.

With each Sweet Shot of the Game, Michigan Sugar Company will donate 25 pounds of sugar – about 850 pounds total – to Rescue Ministries of Mid-Michigan, which operates the City Rescue Mission in Saginaw, Good Samaritan Rescue Mission in Bay City and Community Village, a senior living community in Saginaw.

"We are extremely thankful for the corporate and practical generosity of Michigan Sugar," said Dan Streeter, President and CEO of Rescue Ministries of Mid-Michigan. "They have always been concerned about the needs of our region. It is a tremendous asset for our community to have a local company concerned for local people.

"We are greatly appreciative of this 'sweet' donation and the positive hospitality impact that it will have to provide hope and care for more than 2,200 men, women and children seeking shelter at Good Samaritan Rescue Mission or City Rescue Mission of Saginaw."

The Sweet Shot of the Game promotion is patterned after the Michigan Sugar Home Runs promotion launched this year by Michigan Sugar Company and the Great Lakes Loons. Through that promotion, Michigan Sugar donated 10 pounds of sugar for each home run hit this season by the Loons minor league baseball team. During the regular season, the Loons belted 84 homers and the company is donating 1,000 pounds of sugar (after rounding up).

Each year, Michigan Sugar Company donates upward of 65,000 pounds of sugar to charitable organizations and causes throughout Michigan.

"The Michigan Sugar Home Runs promotion and now the Sweet Shot of the Game promotion are just two examples of how Michigan Sugar Company is working to make a positive impact in our local communities," said Rob Clark, Director of Communications and Community Relations for the company. "We are excited to partner with Rescue Ministries of Mid-Michigan to help make 'home' a bit sweeter for those who rely on the agency for services.

"At the rescue missions, they are known to say 'There's no place like home – unless you don't have one.' At Michigan Sugar Company, we understand the importance of helping make these accommodations as close to a 'home, sweet home' as possible. We hope our donation of sugar for use in the kitchens at these facilities does just that."
