Although Michigan Sugar Company is not aware of anything in our sugar products that would be considered unlawful under Islamic Law, we make no claims regarding the lawfulness of our sugar products under Islamic dietary laws. We provide the following statement to help consumers discern the suitability of our sugar products in meeting their religious dietary requirements:

Absence of Animal Derived Products and Alcohol in Sugar

Sugar products including granulated, powdered and brown sugars produced by Michigan Sugar Company do not contain any materials of animal origin or ethanol. Ethanol is commonly referred to as alcohol or ethyl alcohol. Additionally, there are no materials with animal derived components or ethanol used in the sugar extraction process.
