None of the nine major food allergens identified by the FDA (peanuts, soybeans, milk, eggs, fish, shellfish, tree nuts, wheat and sesame) are contained in Michigan Sugar Company's granulated, powdered and brown sugar products.

Our sugar products contain trace amounts of sulfite as a result of the process used to extract sugar from sugar beets. The sulfite level in sugar is always below 10 ppm and therefore is not required by the FDA to be listed on the label.

Michigan Sugar Company's Allergen Control Policy states that no allergenic substances are allowed in any processing, packaging, or warehousing environments. Allergen awareness training is conducted annually for all necessary employees.
